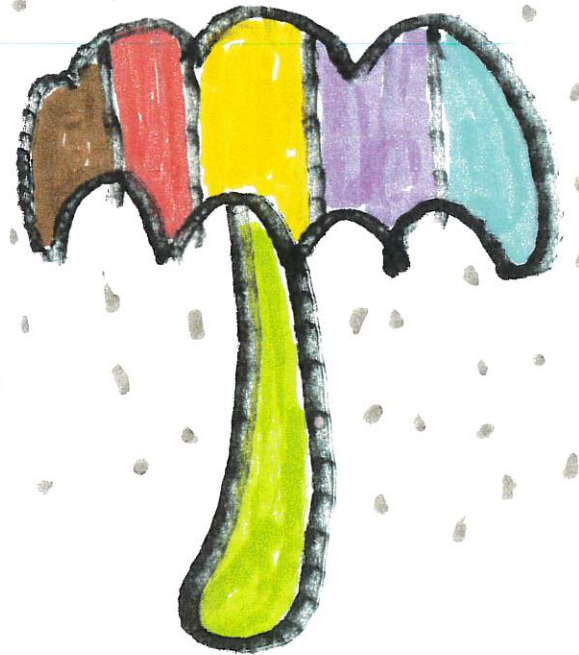

April 13 This is National Scrabble day. The day was chosen in honour of the inventor of Scrabble (Alfred Masher Butts).

April 17 This is Haiku Poetry Day. This is the day when the whole world honours the Japanese poetry form of Haiku. A Haiku is a poem which consist of a 3-line structure. On this day, the celebrations include poetry readings, a film festival, and haiku gatherings around the *world.

April 17th In 2025, this day is Maundy Thursday, a day when the head of the Royal Family attends a Religious Service and gives money to the poor people of this country.

April 18th This year this day is Good Friday, a Bank Holiday in the United kingdom which celebrates the Crucifixion of Jesus Christ and his death at Calvary. The traditional food eaten on this day is the Hot Cross Bun.

April 18th This is World Heritage Day which is an International Day for monuments and sites. This day promotes awareness about the cultural heritage of humanity.

April 19th This is World Circus Day. This day takes place on the 3rd Saturday of April each year. World Circus Day is a special day to celebrate Circus Arts and Culture.

April 23rd This day is St George's Day. St George is the Patron Saint of England. The annual celebration of Saint George is not a national holiday in the United Kingdom but is celebrated by flying the English flag and by taking part in traditional English activities such as Morris Dancing.

April 30th This day is International Jazz Day, a celebration for those who can see the value. This day brings together communities, schools, artists, historians, academics', and jazz enthusiasts all over the world to celebrate and learn about jazz, its roots, its future and its impact.

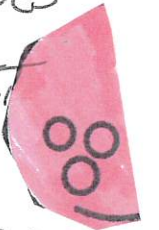
THE WOMENS RUGBY UNION TEAM WON THE 6 NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP



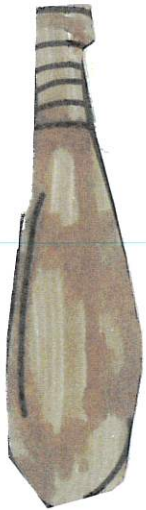
THE GRAND NATIONAL HORSE RACING BEGAN ON 5th.
