## September 2025

September sees the start of Autumn, At the start of Autumn, the leaves change from green to a red and golden colour. In America, Autumn is known as the fall. The birds fly away, some of them to warmer climates, some to escape the cooler weather to come during the autumn and winter ahead. The trees change colour, and the farmers gather the fruit and vegetables they have grown in preparation for the Harvest Festivals later in the month and during the early part of October. Some of the produce from the Harvest Festivals is given to the churches who then give it to the poor people of our county. The Autumnal Equinox takes place on September 21st. on that date the night and the day are of equal length. The full moon is on September 7th. The flower of the month is the Aster, which is a pretty flower. The precious stone of the month is the Saphire. The conquers start to appear in late August, have their prime time in September and are still plentiful in October, although some may start to soften or decay if left too long. In Heathfield the conkers probably start in early September with the best ones ready to pick in mid to late September.

In September 2025, the main events will be as follows:

September 1<sup>st</sup> was a Labor Day, a day celebrated in the United States of America, to honour the contributions of workers to the strength, prosperity and well-being of the country. It was first celebrated in 1882 in New York City and became a federal holiday in 1894. The Americans celebrate with parades, community events, family gatherings including picnics and barbecues. On the same date Zero Waste Week began in the United Kingdom and the National Nutrition Week began in India.

On September 5<sup>th</sup>, the Teachers Day takes place in many countries, but not in the United Kingdom. This day celebrates the work done in schools and colleges by teachers and lecturers.

September 8<sup>th</sup> is International Literacy Day. This day is celebrated every year on September 8<sup>th</sup> to spotlight the importance of literacy as a functional human right and a cornerstone of personal dignity, social justice and sustainable development. This year the day promotes Literacy in the Digital Era, focusing on how digitalisation affects learning and access to information. This date is also celebrated as Star Trek Day after the long running television series.

September 13<sup>th</sup> is Roald Dahl day in celebration of the author's birthday and from September 15<sup>th</sup> until October 15<sup>th</sup>, the Hispanic Heritage month takes place in the USA.

Locally, the South of England Autumn Show and Horse Trials take place in Arlington on September 27th and 28th from 9am until 5pm. This event offers International Horse Trials, Dog Activities, Country Sports, Harvest Celebrations, Horticulture and Flower Arranging. There are also family events, and the main events include farm animals, bushcraft workshops, falconry, vintage tractors, steam engines and a funfair, as well as food and shopping.

The Moto Grand Prix took place in Japan on September 28th.




Athletics The World Athletics Championships took place in Tokio Japan from September 13<sup>th</sup> until September 21<sup>st</sup>.

Golf The Ryder Cup, which was won by Europe, took place in New York from September 26th to the 28th.

Rugby Union this month with the Women's World Cup taking centre stage throughout the whole month. The top matches of the tournament, which was won by England, were the New Zeland game against South Arica on September 9th and the Australia v Argentina game on September 13th. The climax to the month's Rugby, all of which took place in England was the Women's World Cup Third Place Play Off and Final at Twickenham on September 27th.

The only Gold Medal that England won in September 2025 was gained in the Women's World Rugby Union Cup, but the best performances elsewhere came in Athletics with silver medals for James Wightman in the Men's 1500 meters, Amy Hunt, the Athlete, in the Women's 200 meters and Georgie Hunter in the Women's 800 meters, so well done to the Women for these awards. This is only the second time that Great Britain, which was placed 21st in rank order of countries, has failed to win the World Athletics Championships.
